Pahokee Mission 2012

The Commandery of the Palm Beaches has AGAIN adopted a Mission project working together in partnership with Memorial Presbyterian Church and Mike Olive (www.2AllNations.com), serving the needs of underprivileged children in Pahokee, Florida.

This mission outreach will take place the week of June 10-15, 2012.

A summer camp for 50 kids ages 4-14 will be run roughly from 8:30 to 2 or so each day, with work projects going on at the same time and thereafter.

Here's how you can help:

1. Hands on – Join us for a day (or two), or the whole week (\$400 donation to cover lodging and meals) to

- Assist the Summer Camp and reach out to and work with inner-city high risk kids ... sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ through:
 - ◆ Bible study
 - ◆ Arts & crafts
 - ◆ Games and sports
- Assist with work projects

2. Hands off – make donations of:

- Clothing (especially for ages 4-14) including sports apparel, underwear, socks (will accept adult sizes, too)
- Towels and bedding items
- Sports equipment: basketballs, footballs, & volleyballs
- Non-perishable food: rice, beans, pasta, tomato paste, cereal, canned goods
- Personal Hygiene products: toothpaste, tooth brushes, band aids, Neosporin, hand sanitizer, body wash, shampoo, insect repellent, small sizes of soaps, hair products
- Laundry products (small sizes, too)
- Paper products (paper towels, toilet tissue, disposable diapers)
- Financial support
