Dagmar Commandery has from their beginning, concentrated in getting highly qualified members, who can each give a significant input in founding a Centre of Excellence in Paediatric Palliative Care. The project is very demanding and has required a lot contacts and legal preparations before the Dagmar Commandery Foundation could have permission to start practical activity. According to the Danish legislation, this type of foundation requires a minimum of 300 founding members/donors from the EU area and therefore many members of the Order have become support members. In total there are now 384 donor members from 13 countries around the world.

The Core Mission is to provide a home-from-home environment free of charge, offering expert nursing and medical care, including the management of difficult symptoms, for children and adolescents at end of life, alongside practical and emotional support for their families.
