

- 1) communicating prayer requests to the Council,
- 2) sending cards (Get Well, One Day at a Time, Condolences, or upbeat news such as weddings, births, graduations, retirements, etc.). We also will check-in on progress. If requested, we will visit. Most of you are clear on how broadly you want a situation communicated. Whether to the Council, only the Commander, the Commandery or broader if desired.
