

# Hearts and Minds Center (formerly Alzheimer's Activity Center)

This is a past recipient. The center is a large capacity adult day care center licensed to serve 150 persons per day. However, since the pandemic, Hearts & Minds had to severely limit the daily number served. The Center is requesting funds to repurpose a significant section of their outdoor yard. The proposed project is to cover the lawn space with a louvered roof that can be operated electronically. This will increase their activity space by 1320 feet. The Center has received a grant from the CA Department of Aging and is requesting \$65,884 to finish the project.



### **Lupus Foundation of Northern California**

The mission of the Lupus Foundation is to be a premier source of information on lupus by providing programs and services to educate, promote lupus awareness and patient and family support. The organization also supports others with autoimmune diseases. The organization uses technology to deliver many of their programs. They requested \$6100 to purchase new computers, monitors, keyboards and mice.



#### **Grace Solutions**

Grace Solutions serves the unhoused in downtown San Jose. Grace has an Emergency Shelter program in the winter. The shelter is run in the gymnasium in their buildings. Grace is expanding their program to accommodate women in separate rooms. The project will include beds, mattresses, sleeping bags, hygiene supplies, other kitchen and cleaning equipment. The total cost of the project is \$80,000. They have received \$33,000 and are requesting \$47,000 to complete the project.


### Yu-Ai Kai Japanese American Senior Services

Yu-Ai Kai is a 50-year-old private 501(c)3 non-profit providing supportive services and activities for seniors in Japantown and Santa Clara County older adult population. They provide approximately 2500 cooked on-site fresh meals on-site monthly. The kitchen is over 30 years old and they need to replace the freezer, 55-cup rice cooker, can storage rack, kitchen sink and kitchen wall panel. They also transport meals through Meals On Wheels and need Thermal Food Transport Bags. They are requesting \$48,000 to upgrade the kitchen.



### **Live Oak Adult Day Services**

This request comes from the Live Oak Adult Day Services center in Willow Glen. The center has been in use for 23 years and needs upgrades to the facility. The property perimeter fence needs to be replaced. Also, the flooring in the program room has become worn down and the clients and staff can't push the chairs up to the tables. They are requesting \$25,000 for the upgrades.
